



Covid Catch-up Funding

The government gave additional funding to support children and young people to catch up lost time after school closure. This is especially important for the most vulnerable and disadvantaged backgrounds.

At St Bernadette's Catholic Primary school we received a total allocation of £9894.00 in catch up funding and have used the funding to support our children in the following way.

£4634.22	Additional TA hours to support children who had fallen behind age related expectations in all year groups from Reception up to Year 6. These hours focussed on key skills of reading – including phonics, writing and mathematics	As a result of additional support children are achieving well, have caught up lost learning and teacher assessment indicates that most children are now on track to meet end of year expected standards (December 2020)
£1614.00	IPads purchased to facilitate online interventions across the curriculum in school and to enable children self-isolating to access online learning.	
£180	Corbett Maths Resources to support Year 6 in catching up on key skills and concepts.	
£540	White Rose Maths resources and books to support maths interventions	
Balance: £2925.78	Balance will be allocated when children return to full schooling on Monday 8 th March and Teacher assessment is complete. Early Year will be allocated additional TA hours to support our youngest children.
