- London is the capital city of England
- Edinburgh is the capital city of Scotland
- Cardiff is the capital city of Wales
- Belfast is the capital city of Northern Ireland
- Dublin is the capital city of Republic of Ireland
- Compass Points North East South West (Naughty Elephants Squirt Water)
- My school is in Lancaster, Lancashire Northwest England
- Lancaster physical features, River Lune, beck, hills, trees
- Lancaster human features – Castle, Priory, canal, Cathedral, Ashton Memorial, Williamson Park
- Equator is halfway between the North and South Poles and divides the Earth into the northern and southern hemispheres
