- ❖ Ensure your child feels happy, safe in order to achieve the best possible learning outcomes.
- ❖ Work in partnership to ensure that the needs of the individual are met and adaptations which may be required to enable every child to succeed happily in their learning, are made.

The family agree to: -

- ❖ Encourage and support your child in developing a positive attitude to learning and coming to school.
- ❖ Make sure your child is punctual, attends school regularly and to notify school as early as possible on the day of absence.
- ❖ To accept that where attendance falls below our expectations, you will need to participate in meetings with the Senior Leadership Team to support your child's improved attendance.
- ❖ To support your child's reading journey by reading at home to and with your child on a regular basis.
- ❖ To support and ensure your child completes homework set regularly and on time.
- ❖ Support the school in keeping children safe by supporting school policies on behaviour, online safety, jewellery and medicines.
- ❖ To advise the school of any health or relevant family problems which may affect your child in school, so that we can support your child.
- ❖ To ensure that if your child uses online games, Communication Apps and social media platforms that these are suitable for their age. To encourage personal responsibility when using them.

- ❖ To fully support the school policy on mobile phones – if your child brings their phone to school they must hand it into the office.
- ❖ To fully support school policy on school uniform, including the labelling your child's name on their uniform.
- ❖ Contact school quickly if you become aware of any issue which is adversely affecting your child at school.
- ❖ Attend Parent Conference evenings to discuss our child's progress, as arranged.
