1901 Learie Constantine was born in Trinidad.

1922 Constantine was playing for Trinidad in major tournaments.

1923 Constantine was selected for the West Indian tour of England.

1928 – 1937 Learie Constantine played for Nelson in the Lancashire League

1962 Learie was knighted and became Lord Learie Constantine

1971 Learie died.
