Uniform News

We have been very impressed with how smart the children have looked on their return. All children should be wearing their winter uniform except on **PE days** which are as follows:

Monday – Sycamore & Eucalyptus

Tuesday – Oak & Elm

Wednesday – Oak, Beech & Willow

Thursday – Apple, Beech, Eucalyptus, Willow

Friday – Elm & Sycamore

Uniform Survey Feedback

With regard to last term's uniform survey outcomes, I will be discussing the matter of the Gingham dresses with governors and will report back to you any change in outcome. I have been contacted by one or two parents regarding the colour of the PE polo shirt chosen. As the yellow polo shirt was by far the favourite of the children, and enables our children to stand out on trips and at sporting events, this choice will not change. I have also been contacted by a parent who would like to know if the blue polo shirts will be permitted in the summer term. As the new uniform policy reduced the amount of polo shirts required, I do not foresee that the blue shirts will be permitted. However, I will clarify this with the governors in our Autumn meetings.

One of the main concerns/issues some parents raised was the consistency with which our school uniform is applied. Children also told us that they felt it was not fair when other children don't follow the rules. So please do not be offended if you are challenged if your child is not in the correct school uniform.

Uniform reminders for the Autumn term:

- * Children are not permitted to wear large bows and accessories in their hair. Small clips which keep the hair off the face are acceptable. If your child has had a 'holiday braid' it must now be removed for school.
- * Long hair should be tied up out of the face. We have had some notifications of head lice from parents since our return and the easiest way to prevent their spread is to tie up your child's hair.
- * Jewellery, with the exception of watches, is not permitted in school. This rule is for health and safety. If your child has had their ears pierced within the last 6 weeks, we ask that you come into school to sign a health and safety waiver form. This is **NOT** a parent consent form to wear earrings. In all other cases we ask that all earrings are removed. Should children come to school wearing earrings that they are unable to remove themselves, you may be called to come into school and remove them.
- * Yellow Polo shirts are part of our summer and PE uniform all children should now be wearing their shirt and tie.
- * Boots of any kind are not permitted to be worn in school. If there is adverse weather and you would like your child to wear boots for warmth or dryness, please ensure your child has their school shoes in a bag so that they can change into them on arrival at school.

Can I please urge you to **name all of your child's** uniform so that we can return wandering items to you quickly. There has already been disappointed parents who have been unable to find lost items.

Communications to school

It is with a heavy heart that I write this next section. At St Bernadette's we do our absolute best for your children. We want them to be safe, to be happy, to learn, to feel loved and valued. However, from time to time, issues can arise where parents and carers may feel aggrieved or unhappy with a decision made by school. Whilst we are always happy to hear feedback, both positive and negative, what we will not accept is aggression or nastiness either verbal, physical in person, over the telephone or via email. As this is an issue that is becoming more frequent I need to share with you that **All** staff know that they do not have to accept this kind of behaviour from our families and can and will terminate any such interactions should the communication become unacceptable.

We have also been made aware of how a few of our parents conduct themselves on WhatsApp and Facebook in regard to school. I would take this opportunity to remind you, if I may, that you are your children's first teacher, and they will follow your example. Children often pick up on this type of thing; they can and do tell us in school when they are aware that their parent has posted something unkind about school and screenshots of messages and comments often make their way to the school office from other concerned families. We have an open door policy at St Bernadette's where your comments and responses are welcome. WhatsApp 'campaigns' are not helpful in the long term, and therefore I would ask you contact school directly if you have an issue as we are the ones who can help sort it out. We are currently working with other schools on a shared policy of communications so I hope to be able to share that with you in due course. In the meantime, thank you to the majority who treat us with the love and respect we afford to you all.

Road Safety & Parking Concerns

There have been two near misses involving children since our return to school. Please be very careful with your speed and with where you park. Whilst we understand that drop off in the mornings and pick up in the afternoons are busy and everyone has somewhere else to be the safety of your children must remain paramount. Parking on the yellow lines, the zigzags and near the entrance and exit to and from the church car park increase the danger. If

you are using the church car park, please slow down there have been numerous reports of parents whizzing in across the pavement and through the car park in a hurry.

I have also received complaints from our families who hold disabled badges. They need to be able to use the disabled parking badges in the church car park and have been unable to do so because there have been drivers who use them as a normal space. This is very inconsiderate and I would urge you to refrain from using these spaces without entitlement with immediate effect.

Nasal Flu Immunisations

The School Vaccination Team will be in school on Monday 20th October to administer the annual flu immunisation for **ALL** classes. You will have received an email with a link for you to offer your consent. The school nursing team arrange all aspects of the immunisation programme with parents and carers directly. School, in particular Mrs. Maudsley, do not coordinate consent.

Parents' Evening

The first Parents' Evenings of the school year will take place on Tuesday 25th November and Thursday the 27th November from 3:40pm. These open evenings will be in person and will provide you with an opportunity to discuss your child with their class teacher. The booking form will be made available to you soon.

Data Collection Forms

This year we will not be sending out data collection forms as you can all see the details we hold for you and your child in your Arbor account. Please take the time to check these details are correct and inform the office if changes need to be made. We have had incidences in school where we have been unable to contact parents and carers when their child has hurt themselves or become ill during the school day. This poses a safeguarding issue and does upset your child if you cannot be contacted.
